SUMMARY

Hands-on engineering lead with 15+ years in software (20+ incl. early freelance), a PhD in theoretical physics and four years of international research experience (South Africa, Germany). Currently lead backend engineering at a crypto exchange: high-load transactional systems (Java/Micronaut, Kafka, PostgreSQL), and a self-built custody stack (TRON node, signer, ledger) that replaced a third-party provider without downtime. Run development in an **AI-native mode**: architecture, decomposition and code review are mine; the bulk of code is produced by orchestrated AI agents with AI review gates in CI. Proof is public — nine production services at demo.xhns.org...demo9.xhns.org, built solo in weeks.

- Own backend architecture of the exchange platform: orders, payment-provider integrations, refunds, reconciliation, anti-fraud holds; Java 21/25, Micronaut, Kafka/Redpanda, PostgreSQL, GraalVM native images, Docker Swarm.
- Designed and shipped **awx-custody**: in-house custodial contour (TRON full node, wallet/signer, gateway, ledger-core, broker bus) replacing an external custody provider; deposit→ledger→withdrawal flows with idempotency and reconciliation on every money path.
- Built an in-house **AML transaction graph for TRON** on top of the full node (address clustering, flow tracing) as a compliance service; KYC onboarding via SumSub, anti-fraud holds.
- Migrated the exchange connector to HTX API v3 with backward compatibility; refactored the Earn service to Kafka-based event flow (Micronaut 5 / Java 25, native image).
- Introduced AI-native engineering: agent orchestration for implementation, AI code review in CI (MR auto-review), evaluation harnesses (classifier accuracy 40% → 100% via named-class prompts), documentation-first context for agents. Team reduced to 4 after restructuring — throughput kept.
- Lead a small team hands-on: decomposition, review, mentoring, release management across test → prerelease → prod.
